

Hydrogen and Fuel Cell Futures – the transition to sustainable transport energy

Prof. Xinhe Bao was invited to attend the Conference of "Hydrogen and Fuel Cell Futures - the transition to sustainable transport energy" on 12-15 September 2004, in Australia. The conference was hosted by the Government of Western Australia, Department for Planning and Infrastructure. This is the first of its kind in the Southern Hemisphere, which provides comprehensive coverage of the most likely future energy provision arrangements currently being identified across the globe. The topics include:

The latest developments in the world of sustainable transport energy and strategies for the future;

Current research and trials of fuel cells and hydrogen powered transport;

What the next steps might be in the transition to a hydrogen-based future.

The conference brings together international experts in the fields of hydrogen, fuel cells and sustainable transport energy policy, politics and practice. Prof. Xinhe Bao was one of the 20 invited speakers at the conference and he gave a presentation on "R & D Activities of Fuel Cell and Hydrogen Technology in China".
